Thanks to all the volunteers and to everyone who donated items for the meal and the bazaar table. The church served over 150 people at this year's event, including many from the surrounding community.

The church received \$2,443 in free will offerings and the bazaar brought in another \$783. After expenses, the church will be able to donate \$3,030 to Dorothy's House, a non-profit organization that provides residential care, support and counseling to women who have been impacted by human trafficking, exploitation and prostitution.
