A NOTE FROM PASTOR JOYCE

This is the entry for January 1st:

Dwell not on the past – only on the present...Bury every fear of the future. I hold the year in My Hands – in trust for you. But I shall guide you one day at a time...and for each day I shall supply the wisdom and the strength.

My prayer for you and your family, that you would let go of the challenges and disappointments of 2024. Be hopeful and hope-filled as you trust God to lead you into the year ahead.

DECEMBER HAPPENINGS


December was a busy month for the church. Thank you to everyone who played a part in planning, decorating, providing food, wrangling kids and animals. Check out the pictures below!

Enjoy a time of worship, followed by a soup lunch and our favorite tailgate foods.


