A NOTE FROM PASTOR JOYCE

HOW IS IT WITH YOUR SOUL? This is a question that John Wesley encouraged Christians to ask of one another, and it's a good question, isn't it? In our world today, it can be easy to neglect our souls. We can get so focused on our family, our job, our finances, or any number of other things, that we can forget about the need to take care of our souls.

What do our souls need? There are the obvious things: worship, for example, and prayer; reading God's word and getting together with other Christians. But our souls can also be nourished by other things, too, like spending time in God's creation, or by reading books that feed our souls.

Beginning Sunday, September 7th we'll start a new sermon series called *Soul Reset*. Fall is a time when we tend to change up our routines. A new school year starts, and we begin new programs and ministries at the church. The idea of a *Soul Reset* is based on a book by Junius Dotson. In the book, he notes that many of the electronic devices we use have a reset feature - something that takes you back to the manufacturer's original settings. If it stops working or you mess it up somehow, you can reset it. He takes that same idea and applies it to our souls. By reset he means rearranging priorities...taking a time out...getting rid of the clutter...surveying the situation...getting back to the basics and charting a new way forward...in order to achieve wholeness so we can live our best lives now. **Did you get that...live our best lives now.**

As we think about fall, I want to encourage all of us to look for the new things God might be doing in our life and in the life of the church. If you've been away for a while, consider whether it's time to get reconnected with God and one another through worship and fellowship. How might God be calling you to reset?

SCHOOL SUPPLY PROJECT




